## Make 8 half-square triangles at once

The formula is as follows: Finished block size x 2 + 1-3/4"

So for a finished block of 4 inches:  $4 \times 2 = 8 + 1 - 3/4 = 9 - 3/4$ "

Choose two fabrics. Cut one 9-3/4" square of each. Place them right sides together. Draw solid diagonal lines corner to corner, both ways, on the lighter square. Draw dashed lines horizontally and vertically down the center of the squares. Sew a **scant** ¼" seam on either side of both **diagonal** lines.

Cut on the **drawn** diagonal lines, then cut on the dashed vertical and horizontal lines. You now have 8 half-square triangles. Square up and cut off the ears.
