

Transparency, Color and Value Study Workshop

In this workshop you will learn to identify value (Dark, Medium Dark, Medium, Medium Light and Light) in color. We will use solid fabrics for the transparency area and you may choose either your lightest or darkest fabric (your background) to be either a solid or print fabric.

We will meet the evening prior to the class at Joann's in
Mt. Vernon, for 30-60 minutes for fabric choice evaluation, where I will instruct you on how to see your colors as values. You may choose to purchase your 3 fat quarters of solid fabrics at this time or go home and raid your stash for 3 fat quarters of solid fabrics. You will also need 1/2 yard of either a print or solid fabric from your stash that reads as your darkest or lightest fabric in the group of 4 fabrics.

The following day you will cut and assemble your fabrics, with instruction, into your large block (at right) into a visual 3D transparency. You may choose to finish your block into a small quilt, a pillow cover or leave it unfinished and use it as a guide for future projects.
