Due at the First meeting in June

Geese Migration

Measure twice cut once.

This block measures 12 ½ inches unfinished.

Keep the color monochromatic to one of your favorite pastel choices. Choose a mix of dark, medium, and light colors. All blues, purples, pinks, yellows, etc.

Cut 24 2 ½ inch blocks of dark, medium and light of your color choice. Arrange them to make a piece with 6 rows of 4 squares each stitching them together to make a block 8 ½ by 12 ½.

Set aside and make the flying geese blocks.

Cut 6 rectangles for the geese part of the flying geese block either a dark or light color choice 2 ½ by 4 ½.

Cut 12 squares for the corners of the flying geese blocks 2 ½ inches (light if you chose dark for the geese or dark if you chose light for the geese.)

Sew the newly made flying geese blocks together in a strip of 6 geese measuring 4 ½ by 12 ½

Sew the two components together with the geese strip on the right side of the first block set you made using the 2 ½ squares
