Pumpkin Block

10 1/2 inches Unfinished

Due the first meeting in November

Remember to measure twice and cut once

This block can be made 2 ways. Either with 5 strips or 20 small blocks

For both blocks, the top strip and each corner of the pumpkin are made the same.

Top and corners:

cut 2 strips of white : 2 1/2 by 4 3/4 inch

cut 1 green rectangle 2 by 2 1/2 inch

attach one of the 2 1/2 by 4 3/4 inch to each side of the green rectangle and set aside.

cut 4 white squares 2 1/2 inch's. draw a diagonal stitching line across each of the white squares and set aside.

Striped Pumpkin:

Cut 5 strips 2 1/2 inch's by 8 1/2 inch from a variety of orange fabrics and stitch them together lengthwise to make a block 8 1/2 by 10 1/2 inches

Corners and top strip for both pumpkin blocks:

Place one of the white 2 1/2 inch squares in each corner of the striped block and sew along the diagonal to angle the corners to make the pumpkin shape. Cut away the excess triangle from the corner.

Attach the top strip to the pumpkin base to finish the block

Square Block Pumpkin:

Cut 20 2 1/2 inch squares out of a variety of orange fabrics and sew them into 4 strips of 5 squares to create the pumpkin block 8 1/2 by 10 1/2.

Attach the corners and then the top strip as described above in the Striped Pumpkin.

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
