

Three Quarter Square Triangle Blocks

Choose two (or four) different fabrics. Cut (4) 3-1/4" x 6" rectangles.

Sew two sets of different fabrics on the long edge. Press seam open. Place the two squares right sides together with seams going one horizontal and one vertical. Sew ¼" seam all the way around the edges. Press.





Cut the square diagonally in both directions. Press seams to the whole triangle side. Square up to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares.

Arrange the four squares any way you want, and stitch together to make one 6-1/2" unfinished (6" finished) block.







NOTE: If you want bigger blocks, the measurements are:

8-1/2" unfinished: Cut the rectangles 8" x 4-1/4"

9-1/2" unfinished: Cut the rectangles 9" x 4-3/4"

10-1/2" unfinished: Cut the rectangles 10" x 5-1/4"

...and so on
