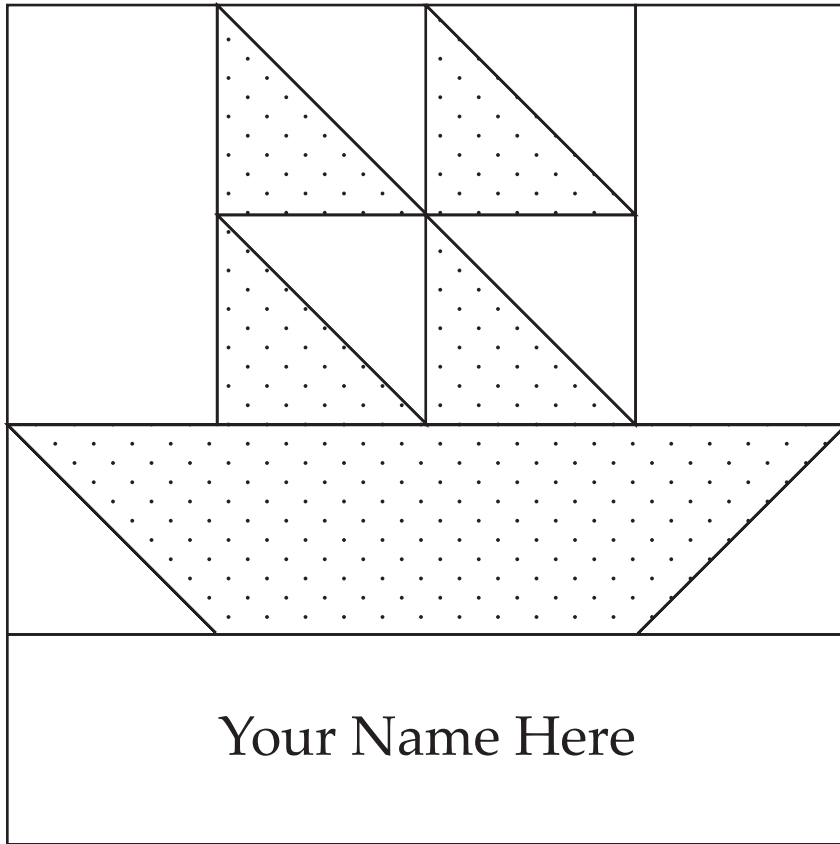


Fidalgo Island Quilters Name Tag Pattern

Traditional Method

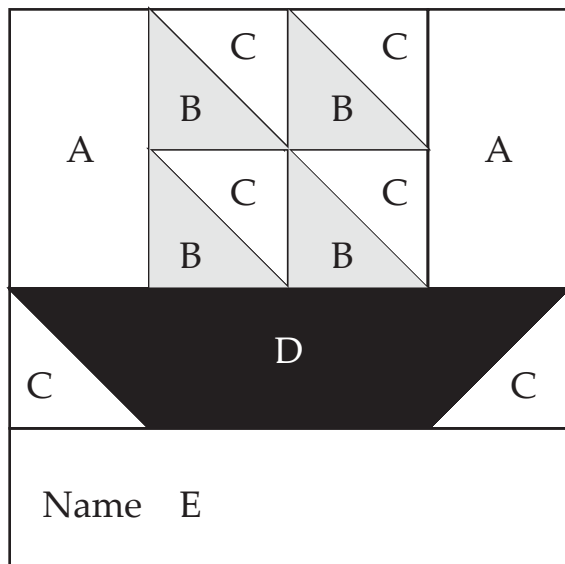


F.I.Q. may be stitched on boat if desired.

- Actual size pattern- no seam allow included, please add 1/4" around each piece.
- Using your own fabric, make a name tag with
 - Blue Water
 - Lt. Blue Sky
 - Red Boat
 - White Sails (or fabric of your choice)
- Choose one finishing method
 - 1) Baste together with backing & batting, quilt and then bind with fabric of your choice.
 - 2) Lay backing & name tag right sides together, put batting on top of name tag, Stitch 1/4 inch from edge leaving an opening to turn. Turn, slip stitch opening, and quilt to finish.
- Stitch safety pins on back & wear to quilt meetings!

Fidalgo Island Quilters Name Tag Pattern

Traditional Method



A - Cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips light.

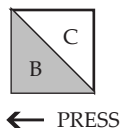
B - Cut 2 - 1 7/8" squares medium. Cut in half diagonally.

C - Cut 3 - 1 7/8" squares light. Cut in half diagonally.

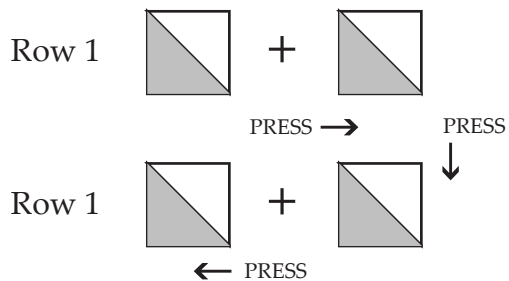
D - Cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/4" strip dark.

E - Cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip.

1) Sew B to C.
Make 4. Press to B.

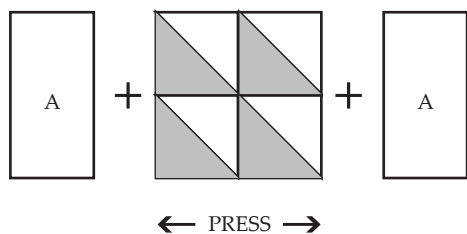


2) To make the sail unit:

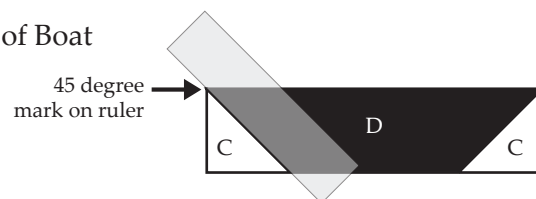


Set row 1 to row 2. Press seam down.

3. Sew A to each side of the sail unit.



4. Bottom of Boat

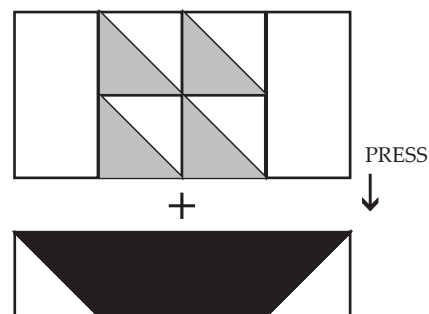


Put the 45 degree angle mark of the ruler on the top of D piece. Make the 45 degree cut.

5. Sew one light C to each side of the boat. Press seams away from boat bottom.



6. Sew sail unit to bottom of boat. Press seams toward boat bottom.



7. Sew E to the bottom of boat. Press seam to E.

Foundation Pieced

Cut sections apart and foundation piece each section. Leave paper on and sew Unit A and unit B together. Sew the combined units to unit C. Trim block, leaving a generous 1/4". Remove paper.
