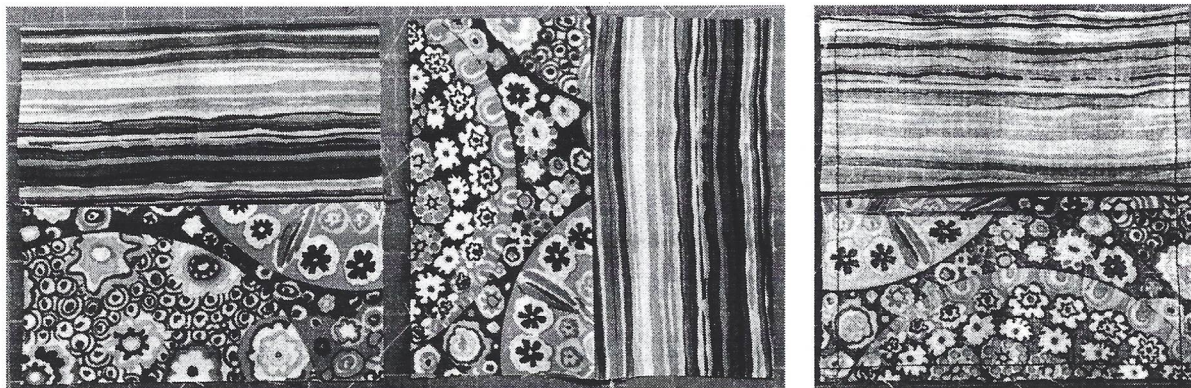


Three Quarter Square Triangle Blocks

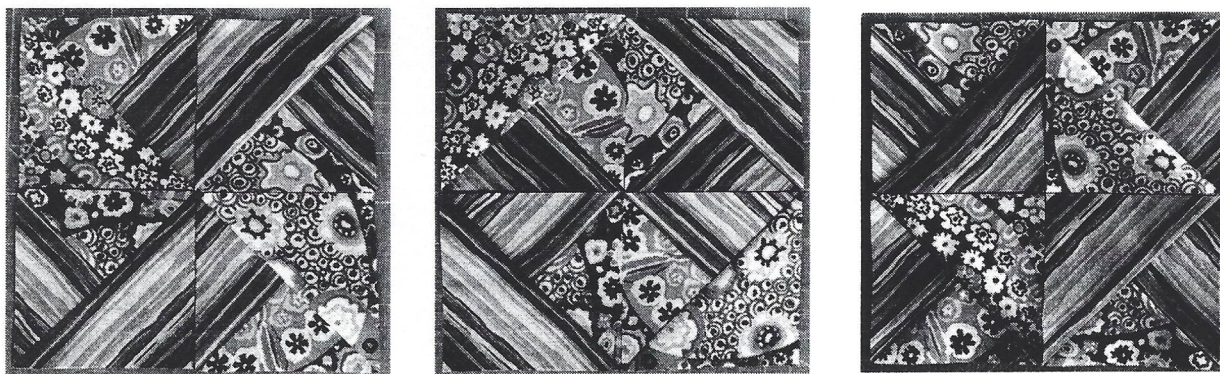
Choose two (or four) different fabrics. Cut (4) $3\text{-}1/4'' \times 6''$ rectangles.

Sew two sets of different fabrics on the long edge. Press seam open. Place the two squares right sides together with seams going one horizontal and one vertical. Sew $1/4''$ seam all the way around the edges. Press.



Cut the square diagonally in both directions. Press seams to the whole triangle side. Square up to $3\text{-}1/2'' \times 3\text{-}1/2''$ squares.

Arrange the four squares any way you want, and stitch together to make one $6\text{-}1/2''$ unfinished ($6''$ finished) block.



NOTE: If you want bigger blocks, the measurements are:

$8\text{-}1/2''$ unfinished: Cut the rectangles $8'' \times 4\text{-}1/4''$

$9\text{-}1/2''$ unfinished: Cut the rectangles $9'' \times 4\text{-}3/4''$

$10\text{-}1/2''$ unfinished: Cut the rectangles $10'' \times 5\text{-}1/4''$

...and so on
